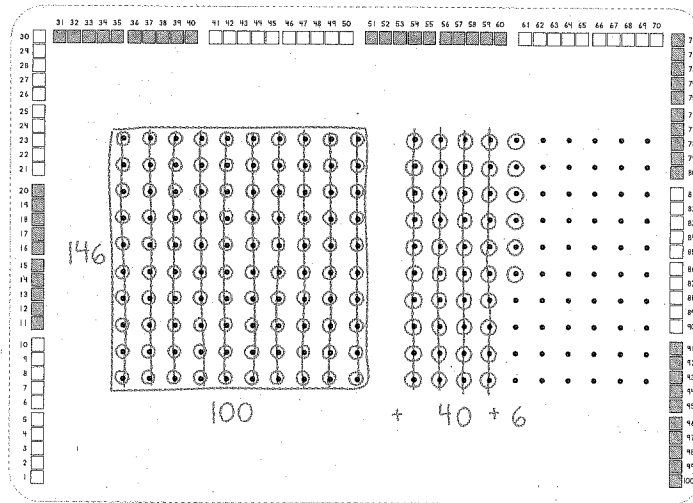


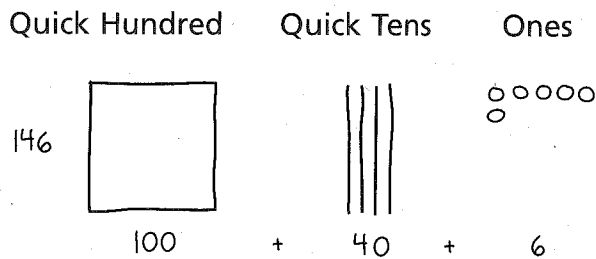
Dear Family:

Then, children will begin to represent numbers using Quick Hundreds and Quick Tens.



Name a 2- or 3-digit number and ask your child to make a drawing to represent that number.

Later in this unit, children will work on adding 2-digit numbers using the drawings to help them.
