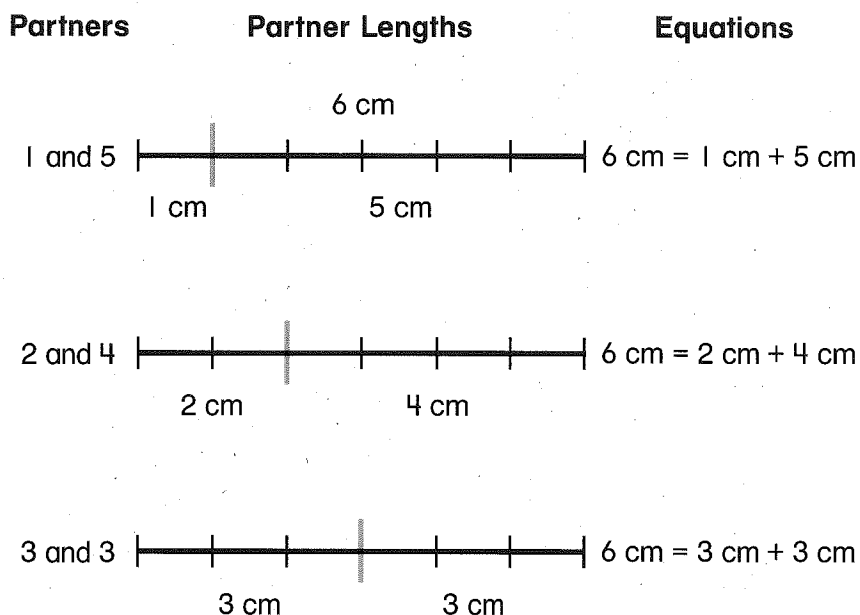


Dear Family:

Your child is working on a geometry and measurement unit. In this unit, children will use centimeter rulers to measure line segments and draw shapes.

You can help your child link geometry concepts learned in school with the real world. Encourage your child to find examples of different shapes (triangles, quadrilaterals including rectangles and squares, pentagons, and hexagons) in your home or neighborhood. This will help your child enjoy and understand geometry.

In Lesson 1 of this unit, your child will be asked to find the partner lengths of a line segment. An example is shown below.
